Eight hundred and fifty personally appeared
before me a justice of the peace within and
for the county and state aforesaid Isaac
Foster. aged sixty one year. a resident of
Mathews County State of Virginia who being
duly sworn according to law declares that
he is the identical Isaac Foster who
was private & sergeant in The Company of Volun-
teers. Commanded by Captain Christopher
Tompkins and afterwards Commanded by
Captain Thomas T Tabb. in The 61st
Regiment Virginia militia Commanded
by Col. Lewis Gayle:

in the war with Great Britain declared
on the 18th day of June 1812 that he volun-
teered at Mathews County in the State of
Virginia on or about the day of
July AD. 1812 for the term of the war.
and was in actual service in said war
at different times in said County for the
period of Twelve months; no discharge
was given you affiant at the close of the
war. altho he was in service at different
periods as aforesaid until the close of the war
as will appear by the muster rolls of his
Company.

He makes this declaration for the purpose
of obtaining the bounty land to which he may
be entitled under the act granting bounty
lands to certain officers and soldiers who have

"United States." paper September 28th 1850
